

## FONDAZIONE FIERA MILANO IS GRANTED THE EPIC PRIZE AWARD 2005

Rome, 29th Septembre 2005 - Fondazione Fiera Milano is granted the Epic Prize Award 2005

Rome, September 29th, 2005 – **Luigi Roth**, Chairman of Fondazione Fiera Milano and **Claudio Artusi**, Managing Director of the controlled Sviluppo Sistema Fiera Spa are receiving tonight at 8 p.m. at Villa Miani, in Rome, the **EPIC Special Award 2005**.
